1. Period: April 1 (Mon)--April 6 (Sat), 2019
2. Theme: Pilgrimage to Haiku Holy Places (Santoka, Issa, Shiki, Hakyō, and Shūson) in Falling Cherry Petals
3. Program (tentative)
April 1 (Mon): presentations, speeches will be held at the office of Meguro International Friendship Association (MIFA) in Meguro City Office
April 2 (Tue): haiku walk to places in connection with Shiki, Issa, Santoka and a park famous for cherry blossoms

April 5 (Fri): haiku walk to river-side promenades famous for cherry blossoms and a haiku meeting will be held at the office of Meguro International Friendship Association (MIFA) in Meguro City Office
April 6 (Sat): presentations, speeches and MIHC Monthly Haiku Workshop will be held at Meguro Citizens' Center
